General Information & Conditions of Entry

If you have any queries regarding these, need further information, or have special requirements please do not hesitate to get in touch. We are practical people - our aim is to help not hinder. 1. General

- 1.1. A steam powered exhibit that is intended to be in steam while on site must have a current boiler certificate and third party insurance cover appropriate to its function.
- 1.2. All stationary engines and static exhibits must have appropriate third party insurance. The organisers may, at their discretion, waive this condition for non-operating static exhibits.
- 1.3. Any self-propelled **ROAD** vehicle or exhibit and driver thereof must be covered by insurance that meets the minimum requirements of the Road Traffic Act irrespective of whether the exhibit is or is not licensed for use on the public highway.
- 1.4 Any driver of a road vehicle on the site must have a full driving licence.
- 1.5. Relevant certificates must be produced when requested.
- 1.6 The event is open to the public from 1100 until 4pm on each day. Please try to ensure your exhibit is in place before opening time, and please avoid departure from site until after closing time if at all possible.
- 1.7 The site will be open for exhibitor access from:-
 - 1200 on Friday 17 May
 - 0800 on each day.

Should you require access at other times, please advise your requirements.

1.8 There is a **height barrier** at the entrance to the site. **This barrier is set at 6'6"**. If your vehicle is likely to require the barrier to be opened, please clearly state on your entry such that arrangements can be made.

1.9 **Camping on site.** Please advise if you wish to camp on site, including which nights.

2. Stationary Engines

2.1. When in operation a Stationary Engine must be attended at all times by either the entrant or a responsible person delegated by the entrant.

3. Model Traction Engines and other similar vehicles

- 3.1. MRT will normally permit the free movement of small models around the site. Exhibitors intending to operate large models must consult with MRT prior to the event regarding the provision of suitable facilities.
- 3.2. Entrants/owners must ensure that their models are only driven by persons insured and competent to do so, and that they are driven in a safe and proper manner at all times.
- 3.3. Engines in steam must never be left unattended.

4. Rail vehicles (2'0" gauge)

Wheelset key dimensions:- Railway is nominal 2'0" gauge, back-to-back dimension is 21 ¼" absolute minimum, ideal is 21 ½".

We will endeavour to store all 2'0" gauge rail vehicles within our sheds.

Unloading via ramp or craneage can be provided.

Operation of rail vehicles at Apedale is subject our Safety Management System, full details will be provided prior to the event.
