- The Classic Car Show at the Apedale Valley Light Railway (AVLR) has been running for many years.
- Last year we saw the biggest turn out with over 220 vehicles attending.

- Pre 2001 Vehicles only! The show has continued to grow in numbers, and we have now nearly reached saturation point. The organisers have now had to make the decision to restrict entries, pre-2001 vehicles only, are allowed on site (other vehicles at the organiser discretion).
- We appreciate people booking up front, entries will close on the 21st August. We appreciate that not everyone has access to the internet to book or will decide on whether to come on the day, we will still allow people to turn up on the day, if there is room and their vehicle complies, they will be allowed onsite.

1. The entrant must be the legal owner of the vehicle or be authorised by the owner to use the vehicle in the event.
2. Entries can only be accepted when this form has been completed in full and signed by the entrant. Please use a separate form for each vehicle.
3. No change of vehicle can be made without prior notification and acceptance of the organisers.
4. You confirm that all drivers have a valid driving licence on the day.
5. You retain full responsibility for your vehicle and your driving in exactly the same way as you do in driving on any other day.
